Rules

1. Negative coggins required within calendar year. Original and copy required on show day, or send copy with pre-entries.
2. All riders are required to wear a SEI approved helmet with harness fastened while mounted.
3. Hard soled shoes with heel must be worn when mounted.
4. All dogs must be on a leash.
5. NO stallions allowed on the grounds the day of the show!!!!
6. Stalls available for \$15 deposit you will receive \$10 back upon inspection of a clean stall from show staff.
7. When signing up for classes, sign up for your riding ability not your age.
8. Class # 1 Best Groomed Horse is for Horseless Horse Grooms(HHG) ONLY, & because it's the first show of the season, your coach may help you in the ring. This class is judged on grooming and handling skills that have been learned so far. HHG may enter the Walk/Trot classes if they feel they are ready.
9. Show will be held rain or shine!
10. Cannot cross enter Walk/Trot with Walk/ Trot/Canter classes.
11. English Showmanship is for both Hunt and Saddle Seat entries.

Riding Levels (Gymkhana Classes)

- Beginner/First Year Members: Have been riding for 1-2 year OR that horse & rider combination has been together for less than a year; WALK/TROT
- Intermediate: Show at Fair but not at State Gymkhana WALK/TROT/CANTER
- Advanced: Rider and Horse combination has shown at State Gymkhana WALK/TROT/CANTER
