Bake Sale Guidelines

Acceptable items for sale

Fruit pies
Cakes and cookies
Muffins
Candy
Bread

- Only *non-hazardous* products may be prepared in the home or other unlicensed facility. *Potentially hazardous* baked items such as crème-filled pastries, some pies, cream puffs, etc., must be prepared in or obtained from a licensed commercial establishment, and must be held at safe temperatures.
- If a bake sale is held in conjunction with, or as a component of, a meal prepared in a licensed or licensable facility and served to the general public, notification shall be made to the consumers that the baked goods are “home-made.”

Serving

- Wrap individual items
- Do not handle food with bare hands. Use tongs, deli tissues or food handling gloves.
- Clean and sanitize food contact surfaces
- Provide trash containers
- Wash hands before serving items – Provide handwashing facility
- All food handlers must be healthy. Must not be ill, have an “asymptomatic illness,” open cuts or wounds. Handlers should not be permitted to use tobacco, eat or drink while handling foods. Proper handwashing should be strictly enforced after restroom use, smoking, drinking, eating or handling garbage, money or dirty dishes.

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
