Arts to show this creation off at the fair!


3. **Floral Arrangement:** Learn how to design beautiful floral arrangements with silk flowers.

- 4. **Beaded Jewelry (grades 3 and up):** Learn the basics of making attractive, fun and personal jewelry! You'll work with beads, wires, and "findings" to create your own look for earrings, necklace or bracelet. Then you'll learn the tools and techniques needed to complete your project and have it to wear!
